TERM AND TERMINATION

- This MoU shall be effective for a period of 1 year from the Effective Date of this MoU and shall be renewed upon the mutual consent of both Parties.
- ii. Both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing in whole, or in part, at any time before the date of expiration without liability to the other Party. In the event of termination, both Parties have to discharge their obligations.
- iii. Either Party may terminate this MoU, if the other Party has breached any of the terms as mentioned in this MoU and fails to cure such breach within fifteen (15) days after written notice of the breach.

ARTICLE 6

FFES & FINANCIAL TERMS

- i. Neither party has any financial obligation to the other Party under this MoU.
- Specific agreements shall be executed between the Parties on finalization of activities covered under this MoU and on a case-to-case basis as and when required in separate Agreements.

ARTICLE 7

CONFIDENTIALITY

i. During the Term, either Party may receive (the "Receiving Party") certain information or materials concerning the other Party's business, technology, customers, and products that are confidential ("Confidential Information" may include, without limitation, computer programs, printed materials, software or hardware products, product development plans, source code, object code, documentation, training materials (printed or softcopies), know-how, trade secrets, formulas, processes, procedures, ideas, research, inventions (whether patentable or not), copyrights, schematics and other technical, business, financial and marketing information, forecasts, strategies, names and expertise of employees and consultants, customer or partner information, customer data.) and other data of substantial value to the other Party (the "Disclosing Party").

The Receiving Party will protect and preserve the Confidential Information as confidential, and it shall not disclose any relevant Confidential Information to any third parties, except for the information that is or will be in the public domain (other than through the receiving Party's unauthorized disclosure); is under the obligation to be disclosed pursuant to the applicable laws or regulations, rules of any stock exchange, or orders of the court or other government authorities.

ARTICLE 8 INDEMNITY

Each Party (Indemnifying Party) hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other Party all damages, costs, legal fees or any other cost arising in and out of or relating to the material breach of this MoU by the Defaulting party.

ARTICLE 9 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Except for the permitted use of 'Confidential Information', each Party acknowledges that, under this MOU, a Party neither acquires any intellectual nor other property, including without limitation copyright, trademark, business or trade secrets, methodologies, courseware or content from the other Party and or any right in Intellectual Property from the other Party. Both Parties agree that they shall share drafts of relevant material and seek permission from the other Party before listing the other Party's name in its marketing material and use the other Party's logo with respect to such listing and for reference purposes.

FORCE MAJEURE

In the event either Party is unable to perform its obligations under the terms of this MoU because of acts of God, Pandemic, riots, or other causes reasonably beyond its control, such party shall not be liable for damages to the other for any damages resulting from such failure to perform or otherwise from such causes.

ARTICLE 13

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

All or any disputes arising out or touching upon or in relation to the terms and conditions of this MoU, including the purpose and validity of the terms thereof and the respective rights and obligations of the Parties, shall be settled amicably. If the Parties fail to do, the dispute shall be settled by the sole Arbitrator mutually agreed by the Parties in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996, and the proceedings shall be conducted through virtual mode.
